- Development of a mechanism to monitor the benefits, impacts and efficacy
- Is this something that the research and evaluation team can look into?

Practical, user-friendly guides to best practices for organizations specifically working to prevent and respond to GBV to supplement IASC GBV guidelines

- Development of guidelines on conducting Situation Analyses on GBV in order to ensure community participation, ownership, and sustainability
- CARE agreed to develop first draft by end of march 2008

“Best Practices” Intranet Exchange via regional discussion boards and information exchange

- Encouragement of IAWG members to post and share GBV-related information via this network
- ARC and WHO to encourage info sharing
