# Training Working Group

- 10.1 Provide clinical training and follow-up, both in the field and at Marie Stopes International comprehensive RH centers in Nairobi and Burkina Faso, to improve quality of care as part of the RAISE initiative
  - Status: Clinical centre operational and training ongoing. Currently trainings are for RAISE-related partners and over time, this resource might be more available to the field more broadly.

## DISCUSSION/RECOMMENDATIONS:

- There is a need to translate some material into French and other languages
- Some of the course material may be used in the Training Partnership.

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- 10.2 Develop an inventory/list of training materials
  - Status: 1) Inventory completed by UNFPA.
  - 2) IAWG Training Partnership reviewed list of training materials to create a standard set of modules for MISp.

## DISCUSSION/RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Establish a list of trainers (Roster)
- Annually review list of current material to flag any that may need to be revised or updated, ensuring wise use of learning technology.
- Develop a system for certification based on core competencies around MISp for graduated learning (Harvard meeting in 2009, WHO on RH core competencies, AMREF core competencies for lab work)
- Ensure that there is supervision and training after completion of coursework to develop proficiency

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- 10.3 Create a matrix framework of training needs and target audiences
  - Status: UNFPA to develop a matrix of modules in RAISE, MISP and Sprint and Training Partnership outreach modules, AMDD, ALSO, etc.
  - DISCUSSION/RECOMMENDATIONS:
    - Ensure that there is advocacy training to develop skills within community – *Champions for the Future*
    - Consider ways for mentoring new generation of RH professionals.
