RH Data and Research

3 main points of action

1. Conduct prospective data collection on selected indicators

- Select 3-6 indicators (TBD)**
- All agencies report these indicators**
- Evaluate ease of reporting, usefulness, quality, etc.**
- Link with modifications in health programs based on the indicator**

3 main points of action (cont.)

2. Populate excel table of data collection activities by IAWG WG/agencies

- Identify strengths, gaps, overlaps**
- Potential web hosting of list (RAISE)**

RH Data and Research

3 main points of action (cont.)

3. Conduct retrospective analysis of data

- Population-based surveys (RAISE, CDC RHA Toolkit)
- HIS data (UNHCR, IAWG agencies)
- Ministry of Health indicators (where feasible)
- Determine which indicators are comparable across data sets
 - Use IAFM as basis for comparison
