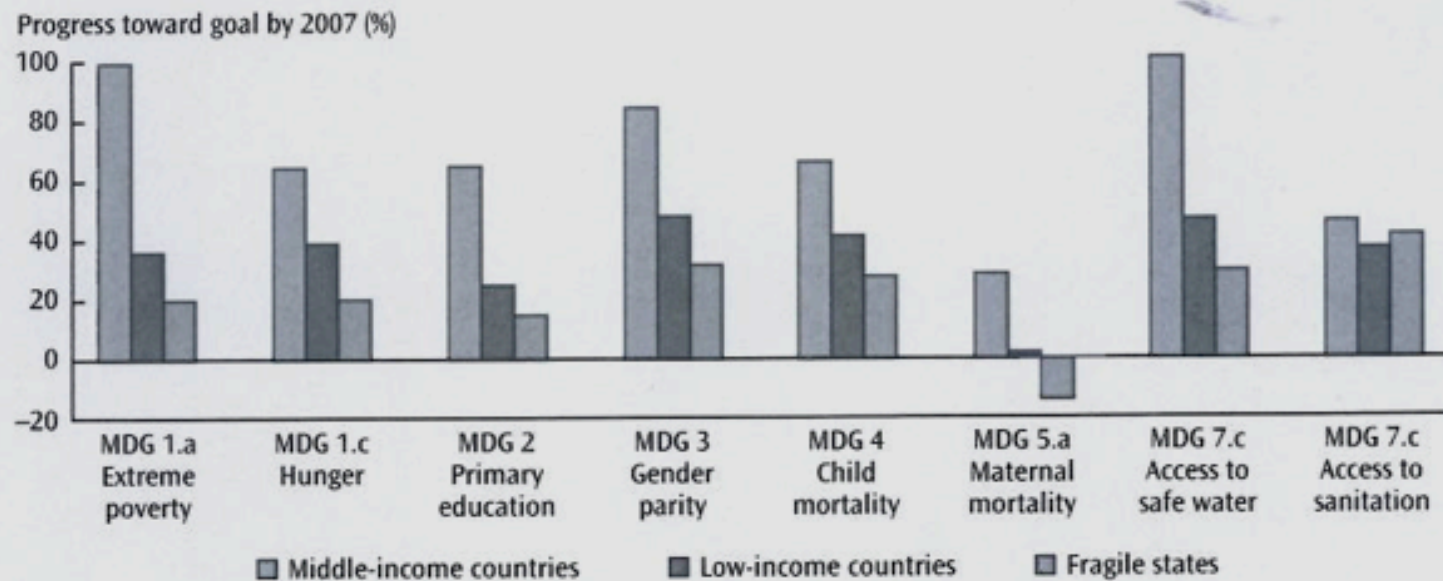
MDGs
