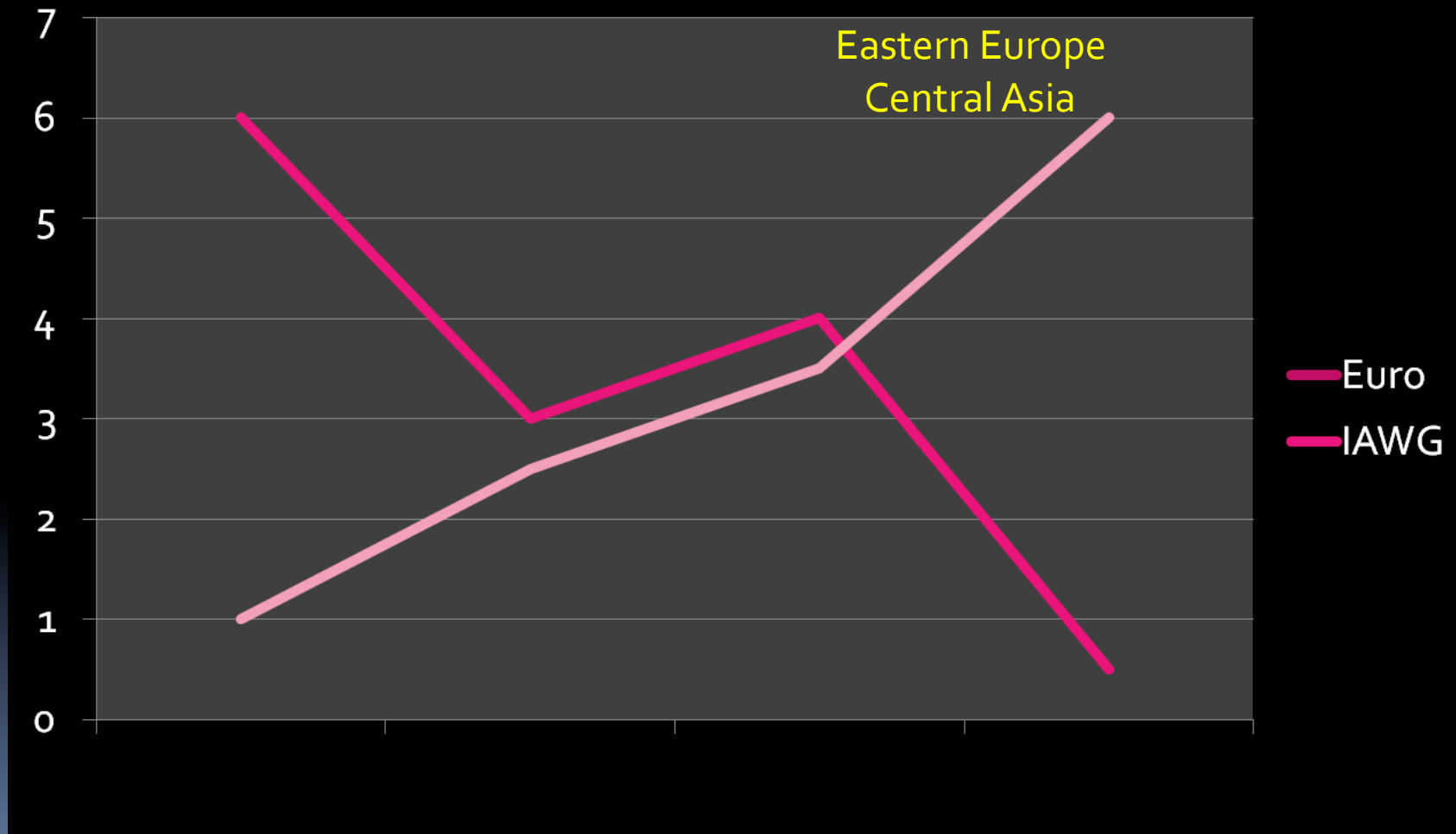




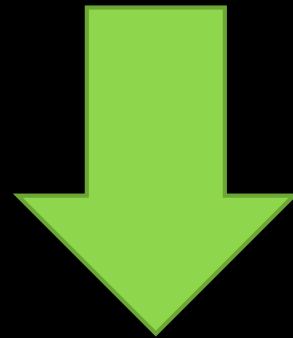

- Disaster risk reduction, contingency planning, emergency preparedness work
- Natural disasters
- Leadership of local players

Attention getting: position IAWG & SRH in humanitarian settings

- 7 billion campaign
 - ➔ Make it OUR campaign
- MISP & Millennium Development Goals
 - MDG 4, 5, 6
 - Engage child, adolescent health & AIDS organizations
- Human rights / sexual and reproductive health & rights within global instruments
 - Maternal morbi/mortality = human rights violation (2010)
 - Report of special rapporteur on the right to health on SRH criminal laws = human rights violation (2011)

Attention getting: position IAWG & SRH in humanitarian settings

- ICPD +20 (International Conference for Population & Development)
 - Position our agenda
 - Global IAWG Evaluation
- UN Secretary General Strategy on Women and Children / International Alliance
 - 100 million new FP users
 - 80 million more newborn exclusively breastfed
 - 67 million more women with skilled birth attendance
- Engage new donors (humanitarian, development)



→ Life-saving SRH interventions in emergencies are non-optional

→ It cannot be implemented by one agency alone



IAWG =
more than the sum of its parts

- **Demand for visibility divides**
 - Support mechanisms to hold governments and agencies accountable for ensuring access to MISP
- **Coordinate, coordinate, coordinate**
 - Empower national leadership whenever possible
 - Critical role of UNFPA/other UN agencies where there is no effective governance
- **High priority to partnership & collaboration**
 - Funding
 - Programming
