INTERVIEW QUESTIONS

Introduction

Thank you for agreeing to be interviewed in connection with the Inter-agency Global Evaluation of Reproductive Health Services for Refugees and Internally Displaced Persons.

The questions that I would like to ask are related to: **trends in funding at the global level, advocacy activities and/or strategies at the global level; changes in policies and practices at the global level affecting the availability of resources; and resources provided through the IAWG/IASC**

I would like to tape-record the interview, if you have no objection to this.

1. When considering trends in funding for reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs at the global level:
 - What have been the main sources of funds since 1995?
 - Since 1995, what factors, both positive and negative, have influenced the availability of funds for reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs? (Possible factors: war, famine, other humanitarian crises, international conferences, changes in government, changes in leadership within key agencies/organizations, etc.)
 - How have these factors influenced the availability of funds for reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs (e.g. caused a decrease, an increase, or a plateau in funding) and what have the implications been?
 - What are the main sources of funds for reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs at present?
 - What do you predict as possible future trends in funding for reproductive health for refugees and IDPs at the global level over the next five years and why, and what implications might the predicted trends have?
2. With respect to advocacy activities and/or strategies in support of reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs:
 - What in your view has been most effective and why? (e.g. conference platforms, global appeals, personal contact with policy makers or others (in-person visits, letters) etc.)

- What do you see as the most effective advocacy activities for the future and why?
3. With regard to policies and practices affecting the availability of resources in support of reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs:
- What major changes have taken place since 1995 and what have the consequences been? (e.g. policy changes within organizations and/or agencies, changes in government policies, etc.)
4. In terms of the contributions made by the IAWG/IASC:
- What particular resources, actions and/or programs have had/continue to have a global impact in support of reproductive health services for refugees and IDPs? (e.g. international conferences and international training courses supported by IAWG member-agencies, etc.)
